LAWN CARE

ALL RESIDENTS AND HOMEOWNERS are reminded that you must keep your grass and weeds manicured and under 6 inches in height. You must keep your trees and shrubs cut back so they do not block traffic sightlines. You are responsible for keeping the sidewalks in front of your property clear of debris, garbage, and weeds.

Do not blow your grass into the street, this can make for dangerous road conditions and cause accidents

Failure to comply will result in a citation being filed and fines issues

GARBAGE PICKUP

Regular trash pickup is every Thursday morning. Trash cans may be placed at the curb anytime after 6 pm on Wednesday. You must remove your cans by noon on Friday, they cannot be left on the sidewalk. Big's will not take TV's, tires, paint cans, or building supplies. **DO NOT PLACE THOSE ITEMS ON THE CURB.** They will take 1 large item per week. If your trash is skipped please report it immediately to Big's at (724)379-4331

*Wilmerding Borough requires ALL trash to be stored in cans with lids.

*Service will be delayed 1 day, pickup on Friday, for Memorial Day.

ORDINANCE #901

Any person having control of any animal must clean up after their pet if they defecate on any sidewalk, street, and public, or private grass area within the Borough.

PA Code 459-305

Dogs must be confined to its owners premises and must be secured to the property or person, such as with a collar and leash, so it cannot stray and can remain under control.

PA state law mandates that all dogs over 3 months of age or older must be licensed and this license should be present anytime your dog is outside of your home.

THERE ARE NO DOGS PERMITTED IN ANY OF THE WILMERDING PARK AREAS. VIOLATORS CAN BE FINED UP TO \$300.00.
